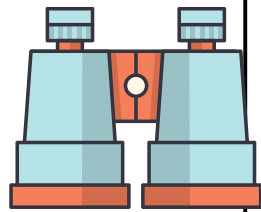

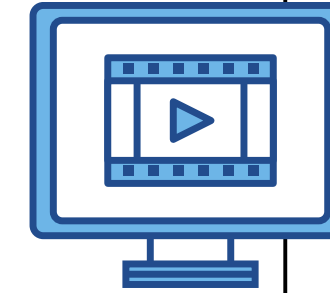

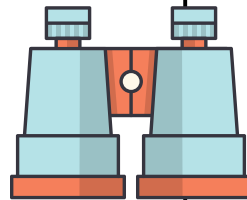

### Jazz music

Jazz music was originally music from a mix of African and American culture. It was first popular in New Orleans at the beginning of the 20th century. Ella Fitzgerald and Louis Armstrong were famous jazz singers. There were also famous jazz bands such as the New Orleans Rhythm Kings.

'Country' music was originally from popular folk songs. 'Western' music was originally from cowboys. Country and western music is a mix of both types of music. It was first popular in the 1920s. The songs often tell stories about people's lives and feelings. Johnny Cash and Glen Campbell were famous country and western singers.



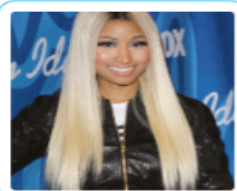
